Facilities included in the project comprises a multi-purpose Main Stadium with a spectator capacity of around 50 000, a Public Sports Ground with a spectator capacity of around 50 000 and an ancillary sports hall with a seating capacity of 10 000 and an ancillary sports hall with a seating capacity of 500, retail and dining outlets with gross floor area (GFA) of about 60 000m<sup>2</sup>, a bowling centre with 40 lanes, a health and wellness centre with GFA of about 2 500m<sup>2</sup>, and Public Open Space of more than 8 hectares. The construction floor area is about 390 000m<sup>2</sup>. Subject to funding approval of the Legislative Council Finance Committee of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the contract is scheduled to commence in 2018 for a period of 25 years (including design, construction and operation period).
