Progress Report on Setting Up of Core Sponsor Group

Purpose

This paper invites Members' comments on the implementation plan for the recruitment exercise of the Core Sponsor Group (CSG) for Major Sports Events.

Updated Work Progress

- 2. Subsequent to the Committee's endorsement of the initiatives and strategies in setting up the CSG proposed by the Advisory Panel via Committee paper MSEC–7/2005 on 10 May 2005, Leisure & Cultural Services Department (LCSD) have secured a venue for the hosting of the Major Sports Events Awards Presentation Ceremony cum Launching Ceremony for the Core Sponsor Group (the Ceremony) which tentatively scheduled for late-February 2006. The primary objectives of the ceremony are twofold:
 - To present awards to National Sports Associations (NSAs) and corporate sponsors of existing major sports events on recognition of their contribution and support for sports development and events in Hong Kong; and
 - To mark the launching of the CSG and enhance public awareness of the formation of CSG.

It is proposed that all NSAs and corporate sponsors of the "M" mark events (e.g. Standard Chartered Hong Kong Marathon) and established major sports events (e.g. Hong Kong Rugby Sevens) as well as all members of the newly-formed CSG be invited to the Ceremony. To signify the occasion, it is proposed that SHA be invited to be the guest-of-honour to officiate at the Ceremony and present awards to the recipients.

Implementation Plan

3. Having considered the strategies endorsed by the Committee, an implementation plan for the recruitment exercise for the CSG is formulated as follows -

In some cases, assistance from particular MSEC Members would be sought as appropriate.	 In order to engage new potential corporate sponsors with a personal touch, tailor-made covering letters together with the promotion packet would be issued to shortlisted CSG candidates. On the advice of the AP, LCSD would coordinate the CSG recruitment exercise with HAB's participation as appropriate.
