## Mock-up Scoring Results for Evaluation of "M" Mark Event Applications

## **Purpose**

In order to further test the usefulness of the scoring table for the evaluation of "M" Mark Event applications, some large scale events which were organized in the past have been selected to go through the process by using the proposed criteria and the scoring table. This paper sets out the results of the test for Members' consideration.

## **Background**

2. Members endorsed the scoring table vide MESC Paper 5/2004. Taking reference for staging of Relaunch Hong Kong Programme in 2003/2004 and other sports programmes held recently, five programmes, namely, Hong Kong Marathon, Hong Kong Rugby Sevens, Hong Kong Open (Golf), Champions Challenge (Tennis) and World Women's Open (Squash) were selected to go through the preliminary assessment with the aims to further examining the effectiveness of the scoring table. Summary of the scores and the mock up results for these programmes are attached at Annex I & II for Members' reference. Basically the mock up results reflect that the proposed scoring table and its criteria can help scrutinize effectively the applications in the preliminary stage. The results of the assessment are seen truly and factually reflecting the achievements of these programmes.

## **Advice Sought**

3. This paper is presented for Members' discussion. Upon Members' endorsement, the proposed scoring table for evaluating "M" Mark Event application will be adopted for use.
